<p>Active-Duty Military Personnel Permanently stationed in the State of Georgia <i>Includes spouse/dependent children</i></p> <p>*Must be renewed upon expiration of military ID on file.</p>	<p>Copy of military orders affirming permanent station in the State of Georgia plus copy (front and back) of active-duty or dependent military ID, as applicable. Dependent may continue in this status if sponsor is transferred so long as student remains <i>continuously</i> enrolled at AASU.</p>
<p>Former Active-Duty Military Must have retired or otherwise separated from active duty within 12 months of first term of enrollment at AASU. <i>Includes spouse/dependent children</i></p> <p>*Nonrenewable—valid for one year only.</p>	<p>Copy of DD214 indicating date of separation within 12 months prior to first term of enrollment at AASU plus proof of intent to establish domicile in Georgia (current lease/warranty deed; GA driver's license). Dependents must also provide federal income tax form indicating dependent relationship.</p>
<p>Economic Advantage Moved to Georgia to accept full-time, self-sustaining employment and established domicile in the State of Georgia <i>Includes spouse/dependent children</i></p> <p>*Nonrenewable—valid for one year only.</p>	<p>Letter from employer verifying start date of permanent, full-time employment plus proof of intent to establish domicile in Georgia (current lease/warranty deed; GA driver's license). Dependents must also provide federal income tax form indicating dependent relationship. Documentation must be received as of the first day of enrollment. May be renewed annually.</p>	<p>Written certification of employment from the human resources department of the employing institution. <p>Active-Duty Member of the Georgia National Guard <i>Includes spouse/dependent children</i></p> <p>*Expires upon return to part-time status.</p>	<p>Military orders that assign student to full-time status in the Georgia National Guard. Dependents require orders of the sponsor being assigned to full-time status plus copy (front and back) of dependent military ID card.</p>
<p>International</p> <p>*May be renewed each fall for the academic year (fall, spring, summer); submit new application and copy of Permanent Student Record indicating 2.5 GPA/full-time status by May 25 each year.</p>	<p>Initial requirements include: Full-time enrollment in courses applicable to declared <u>undergraduate</u> degree (not available for second undergraduate degree) Minimum 2.5 overall GPA at end of each spring semester regardless of term of entry.</p>

<p>South Carolina Border County Resident (Beaufort/Jasper)</p> <p>*Remains in effect so long as student continues as SC resident</p>	<p>A separate Certification of SC Residency form, attesting to minimum 12-month residency in named county prior to first term of enrollment at AASU, should accompany this form (available on web-see below). Other documentation may be required as well. If dependent on parent or guardian for tax purposes, residency of parent or guardian prevails.</p>
